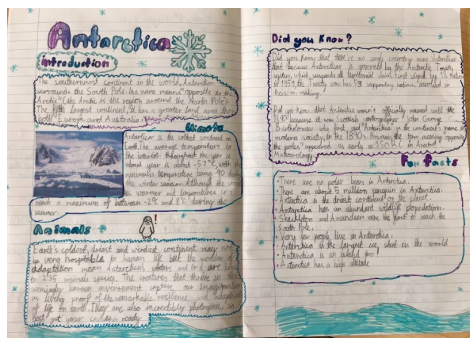

Primary

KG2 have had a wonderful week filled with creative arts activities. They began by making paper poppies in honour of Remembrance Day, and then they painted beautiful flower pictures. Year 1 have been learning about their senses as part of their IPC and science learning. They have explored the parts of the body that are linked to the 5 senses. In English, the pupils have continued with their learning about the class text, 'Rainy-Day Rabbit'. They have created different story openers to start their own narrative writing. In

computing, Year 2 pupils have learnt about what makes a good photo. After discussing this they went out and tried out the techniques they came up with. As part of Year 3's introduction to our topic, 'Young Entrepreneurs', students explored sales techniques through engaging activities, including mystery box challenges and creating video advertisements. Year 4 has begun their 'Young Entrepreneurs' unit, creating fun infomercials and learning about speech writing. Next week, they'll deliver their speeches, putting their new skills into action. They have also been exploring the digestive system in science through fun activities! Year 5 have been exploring their class story 'Ice Trap- Shackleton's expedition' and have been writing non-chronological reports about Antarctica. They researched using their devices and published their writing into their English books. They have worked very hard on this and should be proud of their work! Year 6 have been busy in science with 'Existing, Endangered, Extinct' and 'Electricity'. This week, they created an animal and classified it by its physical features, and learned the scientific symbols for components in circuits.
