This week Year 1 and Year 2 have produced some great written pieces of The Enormous Turnip. In IPC the focus has been on what people do to celebrate special holidays and how the class, could celebrate Christmas. Year 3 have been learning about time, and the vocabulary of time in mathematics. They can tell and write the time to the minute on an analogue clock, which is a very useful skill. In IPC Year 3 have continued to compare one country to another - using Christmas crafts as our topic. The classroom looks very festive with all the incredible decorations. In IPC, the Year 4 students continued to investigate what different countries are like, how the climate affects the way local people live including how their homes are designed and the materials they use to construct their homes. Year 5 have learned all about the different phases of the moon. They started off with good class discussion and finished by making the different phases with oreos. They then had fun eating the moon! Year 6 started their IPC topic 'Space Scientists' by observing a NASA rocket launch. Students then recorded what they know about Space and what they would like to find out over next few weeks. Students also conducted some research about the International Space Station.


Open Davs
