Primary

This week Year 1 and Year 2 have really been able to show their progress in writing with their pirate diary entries. The children even published one of their diaries for display. In IPC, Year 3 have carried on their work on Temples, Tombs and Treasures. They have researched, written instructions and made their own

cartouche out of clay - and then scratched their names using hieroglyphs into the centre of their cartouche. Year 3 have also continued their English text, which has required them to use their imagination as to what they think Leon will find in "The Place Between". Year 4 have been writing their own fiction stories this week after finishing their class text, Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx. For the exit point of their current IPC topic the students are planning and designing a board game with an Ancient Egyptian theme. In Year 5, students have continued working on their topic: The Holiday Show. Students have learned all about the wonders of the world, both natural and manmade and even compiled their own list of places they think should be considered and why. They have continued to work on and edit their websites and completed their wonderful art

There's a prize for the winning destination. The Year 6 students have continued 'The Holiday Show'. They have created a website about a country they hope to persuade others to visit.
