
Primary News

This week the Kindergarten children have started a

new topic called 'Day and Night'. They have been sequencing their morning and evening routines and role-playing getting themselves ready for bed and giving a baby a bath. Year 1

and 2, as part of their IPC, have been looking at art in nature. The children have produced some wonderful art out of leaves. In IPC, Year 4 ran through an earthquake drill - 'Drop, Cover and Hold' in the classroom. Having experienced earthquakes in both Thailand and

Indonesia, Ms Linh was happy to share her thoughts on this topic. The students also enjoyed collaborating on a task using marshmallows. The aim was to see who could build the strongest structure to survive an 'earthquake' - it turns out that working with marshmallows was just too tempting for some. Year 5 have moved on to learning about the Vikings, their third and final ancient civilization. They started a research project about one area of the Vikings, such as exploration, homes or religion, which they will present to the class next week. Year 6 have finished the last piece of their art topic for IPC and are now concentrating on consolidating all of their learning, by planning and preparing for their in-school Exit Point on Monday. They've been doing assessments in English and in mathematics have been learning about plotting coordinates on a 4 quadrant grid.
